# We Players' Wonderland temporarily goes aural and digital

Though We Players had to postpone its Golden Gate Park production of "What Alice Found There" to 2021, amid coronavirus concerns, audiences can now get a taste of how the adventurous company might adapt the works of Lewis Carroll next year, under the leadership of Ava Roy.

Actors from “What Alice Found There” are narrating chapters of the production’s source materials – “Alice’s Adventures in Wonderland” and “Through the Looking-Glass” – in podcast form. Titled “Wonder Story Time With Friends,” the podcast features the mischievous vocals of Sango Tajima (who will play Alice), the richly envisioned characterizations of Alan Coyne (who will play Humpty Dumpty) and the melodic sincerity of Hunter Scott MacNair (a future Mad Hatter), among others.

The company encourages audiences to listen on its [website](#), [Stitcher](#) or [Apple Podcasts](#) while taking a walk through a park – as they will experience the show next year – or right before sleep as a wild and whimsical bedtime story.
